Dine in one of Sydney’s best harbourside locations with great dining options.

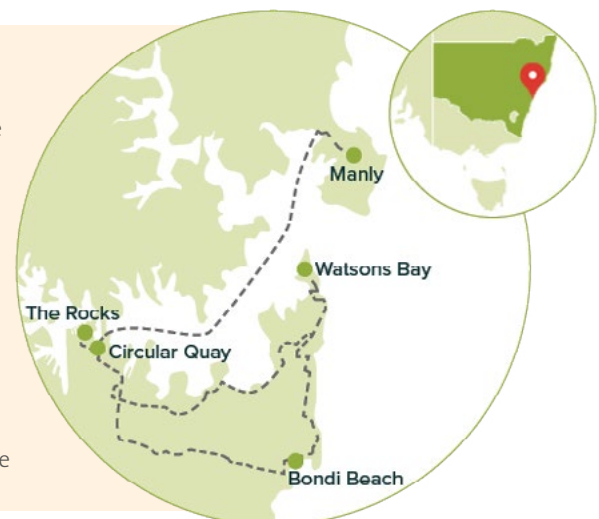

After a day at Bondi, visit Watsons Bay, Australia's oldest fishing village with stunning harbour views over the city. Settle in; enjoy the views, cocktails and the bustle of a friendly crowd before dining one of the most celebrated seafood restaurants.

## MANLY
